
In preparation for the Seussical, the Stage 5 Production students in my class have been working on building the stage in the Hall. Firstly, they cleaned the stage, laid cardboard and taped it all together before laying 3mm MDF, which they had to cut in order to ensure good fitment. They then proceeded to work on the paint. The first step was to prepare the stage for paint with masking tape and sheets of plastic. They then painted the stage with acrylic primer. After waiting a few days, they painted the stage with one coat of 'theatre black', and then another the next day.



However, during this process, we learnt that the upcoming Seussical rehearsal was cancelled.

This presented a difficult situation. Stage 5 Production put in a lot of work in order to prepare the stage for the rehearsals. Students also put in a lot of work with regards to costuming, sound and lighting preparation and other roles, but now due to the fluid situation of the COVID-19 pandemic, we are unsure of how the Seussical will run this year.

At our church, a leader's family was preparing and committing to uproot their lives in Western-Sydney and move to Tasmania in order to aid the churches there. They were convicted of this decision in 2019 and had many conversations with a variety of different organisations and families in the lead-up to their final decision, which was to go and live in Tasmania. However, on the very week they planned to leave, Tasmania's borders were shut, leaving the family in confusion.





As humans, we all have an innate desire to understand and to know, and usually the number one thing that we want to know is the condition of our own lives. These current, unexpected circumstances expose the misplaced faith which we all have to some degree, in our ability to control our own circumstances.

None of us knows how exactly this virus will affect our future, but let's use this circumstance to shift the placement of our faith towards the One who actually holds it all together.


Mr Bill Rusin arrives at Kuyper in Term 2, teaching Science and PDHPE in the Senior School.
