

Uniform Policy

At Kuyper Christian School all uniform is compulsory. If it is temporarily impossible for a student to wear the correct uniform, the student's parent or guardian must send a note to school explaining why.

More than two unexplained breaches of uniform policy will result in a letter being sent home and the student incurring a detention.

The Principal (or his Deputy) has the final say with regards to uniform policy and compliance.

Uniform Shop

All uniform must be purchased from The Kuyper Christian School Uniform Shop. The shop is not-for-profit.

- During school terms, the Uniform Shop is open on Wednesdays.
- The Uniform Shop is also open on Wednesday during Curriculum Week in January and July.
- On all other days, orders for uniform can be emailed to admin@kuyper.nsw.edu.au, phoned through on 4573 2999, or dropped into the office. We will contact you when your order is available for pick-up.
- Hats, library bags, bibles, calculators and replacement diaries can be purchased from the school office on any school day, or any day during the Curriculum Weeks.
- The uniform price list and order form are available from the school office or on our website.
- Payment for uniforms must be made on collection; Cash, Cheque, or EFT. Uniform cannot go on your school account.
- Faulty uniform can be returned within 14 days for a free replacement.
- An incorrect size can be exchanged if the tags are still attached.
- The only items that cannot be purchased at the uniform shop or office are shoes, white, black, sport socks and beanies.

Uniform & Grooming

- Students are expected to model dress standards appropriate to the school Values and Policies.
- All uniform items must be clean, fit appropriately and be in good repair.
- School shoes must be made of black leather and cover the entire foot.
- Sport shoes must be designed for running or cross training only. Lifestyle or sport specific shoes are not acceptable.
- Primary girls may wear buckle shoes that expose a small amount of the top of the foot but completely cover the toes. Due to WH & S, Secondary and Senior students must wear leather shoes that completely cover the foot.
- Hair must be clean and neat and of a natural colour. Hair longer than shoulder length is to be tied back.
- Nail polish or fake nails are not permitted.
- Make-up of any kind is not permitted for students in Primary and in Year 7 and 8.
- Girls in Years 9 – 12 are permitted to wear inconspicuous make-up; i.e. light foundation or powder and natural lip-gloss.
- Girls' dresses and skirts must finish on or just below the knee when standing.
- Shorts for all students must fit the body loosely and finish mid-way down the thigh when standing.
- Headbands, hair ties and clips are to be of a neutral colour, e.g. black, brown, silver, white.
- All items are to be clearly labelled. Unlabelled lost property will be returned to the uniform shop for resale or disposal at the end of each term.

Hats

- Kuyper Christian School has a **No Hat, No Play Policy** for all outdoor activities.
- Students must have their hat with them every day of the school year.

Jewellery

- One small necklace and pendant is allowed, including medical tags. Chokers and heavy jewellery are not permitted.
- Students may wear one pair of small earrings; sleepers or studs.
- One small ring is allowed to be worn.
- One small bracelet is allowed to be worn.
- All other forms of jewellery are not permitted.
- Students are required to remove their jewellery if requested by a member of staff for a particular activity.

Sport Uniform

Secondary students may **not** wear their sport uniform to school. They must bring their sport uniform to change into when it is required. Primary students are permitted to wear their sport uniform to and from school on Sport Day.

Order forms for the Senior Jacket and Year 10 Sport Shirt will be sent home at the end of Term 3 of Year 10.
